b. Sue Bierman Park Playground. Ranee Lan reported on fundraising efforts and is in need of personal contacts from BCNA and others. Seeking a required single donor for naming rights (50% of total cost or approx.. \$400k. The construction documentation is in progress.

c. SWL 322-1 affordable housing project (AB 2649). Bob Harrer reported that this state legislation to remove the SWL 322-1 from the public trust is likely to pass since it has no opposition.

d. Teatro Zinzani. Jim Cunningham reported that the design process is moving slowly through the Port with late 2013 considered an opening date. TZ is opening in a temporary southern California location.
